ROTO-DISC® Co. NOW ISO 9001:2008

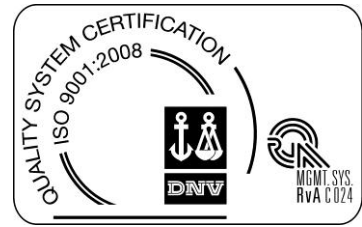
